BMus(Auck), FTCL(voice), BA, Bmus Hons(Qld), ATCL(piano), AIRMT(NZ)

One of New Zealand's most accomplished entertainers, Gina's versatility, professionalism, and beautiful voice have brought her national and international recognition. Gina was the first NZ musician to be awarded a Rotary International Graduate Scholarship for overseas study. Gina can coordinate a variety of top NZ and international professional musicians, solo or ensemble, to present quality musical productions for all manner of occasions – weddings and special events.

Gina has performed at International Festivals and recitals in London, Hamburg, Paris, and Rome to mention only a few. Gina has appeared as a soloist with leading NZ orchestras, opera companies and choral societies. Gina also offers tuition in voice, piano and theory, musical direction, classes in vocal pedagogy at all levels and is an accomplished adjudicator. She has a combined oratorio and operatic repertoire of over 60 roles, holds seven degrees and diplomas in music, education, and languages, and has extensive experience in vocal pedagogy. Gina has made several international tours, and returns annually to Italy, Germany and Jersey for performances and masterclasses which she conducts in the local language.

Now a Teaching Fellow at Waikato University Gina continues her very busy multifaceted career as one of NZ's leading soprano soloists, an advanced teacher, choral conductor, and an examiner. Gina has recently been appointed as the 2021 Director of the Auckland Girls' Choir – a choir which inspires and challenges both music and life skills for those from diverse and sociology-economic backgrounds. Her other interests include being Patron of the South Auckland Competitions Society, founder and chair of the Clevedon Valley Music Foundation Trust and Director of Music at the Clevedon Presbyterian. In 2019 Gina was awarded a Local Heroes Medal at the Kiwi Bank New Zealander of the Year in Auckland for her services to the arts and the community.

The Hawke's Bay Performing Arts Festival will offer contestants the opportunity to experience Gina's amazing talents, in the hope that they, themselves, will move as she has done, forward in their singing careers with confidence.

Instrumental - Susan Melville, Havelock North

LRSM, BSc, DipEd, AIRMT(NZ)

Pianist and conductor Susan Melville has adjudicated for music competitions societies throughout NZ.

She has had extensive performing and teaching experience in Australasia, the UK and Europe, and directed choirs and instrumental ensembles over many years, including the *Hawkes Bay Youth Orchestra* since 1995.

Susan has been guest soloist with *Saxcess*, assistant musical director and chorus mistress for *Opera Hawkes Bay*, a faculty member of *Singing School NZ* since 1999, has recorded for Concert FM, studied conducting at Basel Conservatorium, and performed with many leading NZ musicians, including Jonathan Lemalu, Deborah Rawson, and Patrick Power.

In 2015 she undertook a nationwide recital tour with international operatic tenor Keith Lewis.

Tap - Keelie Nye, Napier

I grew up in the UK, as a member of the National Youth Ballet of Great Britain, attending regular auditions and taking part in musicals and competitions.

When I turned 18, I went to work at Disneyland Paris, first as a dancer and then as a character performer. I was lucky enough to be given the opportunity to choreograph and compete at the Dance Grand Prix world championships in Italy in 2007, where I picked up a third-place title for modern choreography. Upon moving to New Zealand, I continued to teach at dance schools in Auckland and began my IDTA dance teachers associate degree. One of my dance highlights was being selected to perform in the opening ceremony of the Rugby World Cup at Eden Park. I have continued to return to the Walt Disney company as an entertainer over the last 10 years.

Dance has been my passion my whole life, and I am both grateful and humbled by the people and experiences it has brought in my life.

Ballet & Modern - Chantal Pinguet, Kapiti

Chantal was raised on the Kapiti Coast completing her training in New Zealand at Chilton Dance Centre. In 2015 Chantal was accepted on scholarship to Ecole-Atelier Rudra Bejart in Switzerland where she studied ballet, Martha Graham modern technique, percussion, classical voice, and Kendo. With the school, and the Bejart Ballet Company, she performed on stages around Western Europe before accepting a contract with Poznan Opera Ballet in Poland in her second year.

Wanting a new challenge, Chantal began working with Remarc Agency in Greece in 2017 where she danced a range of styles in commercial shows in 5-star resorts across the islands. Falling in love with the job and the lifestyle, Chantal has continued to work the summer seasons in Greece, now as an Entertainment Manager, choreographing shows and directing sports, fitness, and children's programmes.

When home in New Zealand, she enjoys teaching and adjudicating nation-wide. Chantal is the creator of Stage to Studio dance workshops and has recently performed with Unity Dance Company in Wellington.


